With decor running the lines of minimalist exposed brick and piping and oversized black and white photos of restaurant patrons having zany fun, Deleece attracts an urban, contemporary crowd. However, its menu is pleasing to anybody, as it takes a unique, but still recognizable take on everyday dishes with treats such as duck breast in molasses or half chicken roasted in rosemary, thyme, garlic and red wine. More adventurous eaters will find plenty of eclectic dishes, while the more traditional diners will be pleased with classic fare.

If you go for a more traditional dish, try one of Deleece's fun cocktails, such as the deceptively simple-looking but invigorating gin-and-ginger. Or, for a kick in the face after a late night, sip a spicy bloody Mary with your brunch.
