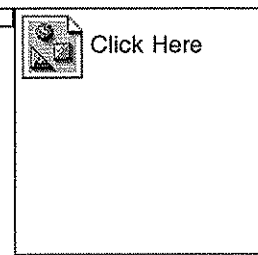

Description

Why aren't more people from Uptown flocking to Nick's? It is without pretension, kitsch, or a theme. One might say it's even boring, but do we need more cooler-than-cool bars? As it stands now, Nick's is a fine place to grab a cocktail or beer, but surprisingly empty for the amount of space it offers. True to the owner's claim, it draws a diverse clientele, but not enough to make it feel as cozy as it could be. Video games, big-screen TVs and other distractions abound, while the average sound and atmosphere remains fairly intimate, even when the bar is empty. The bar offers a bit more upscale beer menu including Guinness, Harp, Bass Ale, Pilsner Urquell and Blue Moon. Nick's Uptown must suffer competition from the food-offering (but cash-only) Holiday Club, but it's ultimately a friendlier and cleaner-feeling tavern. The pool room, with its minimalist, colorful bottle wall decoration is eye-catching, but feels underused. Stop by for drinks during the game or after work and bring your friends, although whether Uptowners prefer to keep Nick's a secret remains to be seen.
